## CALCULATING PROGRAM ASSISTANCE FOR MIXED HOUSEHOLDS AND SHARED HOUSING

## Mixed Household

All household members' income is counted. Assistance is pro-rated based on number of eligible family members. Ineligible members include persons without citizenship, eligible immigration status or lack of homeless status. The examples below would be further adjusted when utility allowances are applied towards the household's share of the rent.

## Example 1: Homeless Family with a Family Member without Citizenship or Eligible Immigration Status

## Shared Housing - Roommates

Factors are: (1) FMR (rent + utility allowances) for shared unit size or FMR for unit sized for client household, whichever is less; and (2) number of bedrooms occupied by the client household. Separate leases are required.

Example 2: Client Household of Three and One Roommate Family requires two bedrooms.

| Program Share of Rent | $\$ 1,028$ |
| Roommate Share of Rent | $\$ 814$ |
