- I. Scoring criteria name on excel scoring tool: Move-in \leq 30 days for RRH & PSH
 - a. Criteria from Attachment 1 Miami-Dade CoC Scoring, Ranking and Reallocation Process
 1. Average length of time to housing \leq 30 days (10 pts)
 2. Average length of time to housing 31-60 days (5 pts)

- II. Scoring criteria name on excel scoring tool: Length of Stay \leq 180 days for TH:RRH
 - a. Criteria from Attachment 1
 1. Average program participation is 180 days or less (10 pts)

- III. Scoring criteria name on excel scoring tool: Exits to PH & PH retention $\geq 90\%$ for RRH, PSH & TH:RRH
- a. Criteria from Attachment 1
1. Retention in or exits to Permanent Housing $\geq 90\%$ (12 pts)
 2. Retention in or exits to Permanent Housing 80-89% (6 pts)

(Total clients "served" – "total" exited) + (Total "positive" housing exits + total persons exit "excluded" from calculation) / (Total persons served)

APR Q.(5a.1-23.c) + (23.c+23.c)/(5a.1)=%

Example: $(37-7=30) + (4+3=7)/(37)=100\%$

- IV. Scoring criteria name on excel scoring tool: Returns to Homelessness <= 10% for RRH, PSH & TH:RRH
 - a. Criteria from Attachment 1
 - 1. Returns to Homelessness within 12 months <= 10% (8 pts)
 - 2. Returns to Homelessness within 12 months 11-20% (4 pts)

From the total housing exits review HMIS system to see if any returned to CoC funded SO, ES or TH since their discharge

1. High Needs Pop: Percentage of households without children who entered from unsheltered situations $\geq 15\%$ (10 pts)

APR Q. 15 Prior Living Situation

Divide # from **“Place Not Meant For Human Habitation”** from **“Total”**

Example pictured below: 17/37 returned = 46%

X. Scoring criteria name on excel scoring tool: High Needs Pop for RRH & TH:RRH

a. Criteria from Attachment 1

1. Programs solely serving Youth - 75% of all referrals came from Homeless or Institutional Situations $\geq 75\%$ (10 pts)

APR Q. 15 Prior Living Situation

Divide # from **“(Homeless Situations Subtotal + Institutional Situations Subtotal)”** from **“Living Situation Total”**

OR

Programs solely serving people fleeing DV or Human Trafficking & RRH - 75% of all referrals came from Homeless Situations $\geq 75\%$ (10 pts)

APR Q. 15 Prior Living Situation (we may use APR generated outside of HMIS for DV projects)

Divide # from **“Homeless Situations Subtotal”** from **“Living Situation Total”**
